Summary of Grading Policy

(Almost) all of the points come from exams.

To “Level Up” on a test, a student must score at least 90% on each section’s homework assignment and at least 70% on each of the 2 chapter quizzes.

Students who do not level up earn 1 point by passing a test (70% or better), and get 0 points if they do not pass the test.

Students who level up earn 2 points by scoring between 70% and 79% on the test, and earn 3 points if they score 80% or above on the test.

If a student who has leveled up scores below 70% on a test, they can retake the test the following week for 1 point.

1 Test is doubled, 3 Points Maximum: 3 Points

Final Exam: 100 Points
